KEY TERMS

RESPONDENT

A student whose conduct is under review is referred to as a Respondent.

PREPONDERANCE

The standard of proof used throughout the conduct process to reach case resolution is preponderance of the evidence.

This standard will be used to evaluate the evidence for purposes of making findings and drawing conclusions for an investigation conducted under the regulation. Meeting the standard constitutes a conclusion it is more likely than not that the alleged conduct occurred.

SANCTIONS

Violations of the Student Code of Conduct, will result in educational and/or disciplinary consequences called sanctions.

Sanctions are designed with the intent of educating Respondents and protecting the ECU community.
